### FROM THE PASTOR

#### GAUDETE SUNDAY

The opening prayer for Mass on the Third Sunday of Advent comes from Saint Paul's letter to the Philippians. That prayer is "Rejoice in the Lord always, again I say rejoice. Indeed, the Lord is near (Phil 4:4-5)." For that reason, this Sunday is called "Gaudete Sunday." That name comes from the Latin word "gaudete" meaning "rejoice." In English we could call this day "Rejoice Sunday." So why this name? Because Advent is coming to an end, and our time to prepare for Christmas is growing short. The rose candle on the Advent Wreath which is lit today is a combination of the purple of Advent and the white of Christmas. It is a sign of our joy. So as Advent draws to a close this week, let us rejoice with the whole Church because the Lord is near.
