FROM THE PASTOR

THE SOLEMNITY OF THE EPIPHANY

Today we celebrate the great feast of the Epiphany. After the feasts of Easter, Christmas and Pentecost, this feast ranks next in importance on the Church's calendar. It marks the day on which our Lord and Savior was made known to the Gentiles, that is, to those who were not Jews. The word Epiphany means manifestation or revelation, and it's an appropriate title for this day. That's because on the Epiphany, Jesus was made known to all the nations through the wise men. These wise men (or Magi) had come from the east in search of a king. They were thought to have come from the region of Persian (present day Iran). The Magi followed a star which had appeared in the heavens and led them to Jerusalem. Upon their arrival, they went first to King Herod. They assumed that he would have information about the new-born king, but Herod did not. Instead, he was surprised by the Magi's inquiries and so, he consulted with Jewish scholars. From studying the Scriptures, the scholars identified the City of Bethlehem as the probable site for the Messiah's birth. Herod then directed the Magi to seek for the Christ Child in Bethlehem. It was there that they found the baby Jesus and worshiped Him. After giving Him gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh, the Magi were warned in a dream that Herod desired to kill the Christ Child, and so, they returned to their homes by another route. This Feast of the Epiphany recalls that day on which the whole human race learned of God's wonderful plan of salvation, that God desired we all live with Him forever as His adopted sons and daughters. As we think of these things, and as our celebrations of the birth of Christ draw to a close, let us continue to rejoice with all Christians.
