LENT IS COMING SOON

Ash Wednesday this year is March 5th, and on that day Lent begins. In keeping with the Church's ancient tradition, all Catholics are called in a more direct way to repentance and conversion during this time. By acts of prayer, penance and almsgiving, we strive to grow in our love of God and neighbor and to overcome our sinful habits. So, before Ash Wednesday, take some time to reflect on how your life will be different during Lent. What changes will you make in your daily routine? What spiritual exercises will you undertake as you prepare to celebrate the great Feast of Easter? With God's help, make plans to grow in His love during Lent.

PARISH ARK ADORATION AND SMALL GROUPS

As Lent is approaching and you are thinking about how you will observe it, I have a suggestion: Why not join one of our parish ark small groups. They meet at various times during the day. Some meet once a week and others once a month. They are comprised of various age groups and charisms. However, in all cases they are about three things: prayer, study and fellowship. Along with your fellow believers, you can learn more about our holy Catholic faith. This in turn will help you see the goodness of God and help you to love Him more. You will be strengthened in your faith by joining with others who share it. This will in turn help ward off feelings of isolation that we can experience living in a pagan culture. Finally, in prayer you will be supported and your prayers will offer support for those in need. So, join one of our small groups for Lent. ADORATION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT

An essential part of our parish ark is Eucharistic Adoration. This form of prayer is a powerful way to grow in God's love. During adoration, you can pray for your families, your parish, and the world. Eucharistic Adoration involves praying before the exposed Blessed Sacrament.
