

FROM THE PASTOR

LAETARE SUNDAY

The fourth Sunday of Lent is often known by its Latin name, "Laetare Sunday." This name comes from the first words of the Entrance Antiphon at Mass, "Laetare Jerusalem." They mean "Rejoice, O Jerusalem." The Fourth Sunday of Lent marks the halfway point on our journey to Easter. As a reminder of this, special signs of joy are permitted during the liturgy to encourage us as we continue on with our Lenten penances. Flowers can be placed on the altar and rose colored vestments can be used at Mass in place of purple ones. These things emphasize the contrast between Laetare Sunday and the other Sundays of Lent, and they are symbolic of the joys of the next life. For now, our joy is restrained and is mingled with a certain amount of sadness, but our joy will be fully revealed when we celebrate our Lord's resurrection at Easter.

EXTRA TIMES FOR CONFESSIONS IN LENT

The Sacrament of Penance is a gift from Jesus to us. In this Sacrament, we have both an opportunity and obligation to receive God's forgiveness and mercy. Make sure you receive this Sacrament and go to Confession before Easter. Besides the regularly scheduled times, there will also be extra times for Confessions during Holy Week. These times will be posted on our Website and in next week's bulletin. Also, we will be having two priests hearing confessions at Saint Patrick's on Palm Sunday, April 13th from 6:00 to 7:00pm.

AMBASSADORS FOR CHRIST

In our second reading from Saint Paul's Second Letter to the Corinthians, Saint Paul refers to us as "ambassadors" for Christ." We have all heard this term before, primarily with regard to official representatives sent from one country to another. However, in another sense, an ambassador can be someone who represents or promotes some activity or organization or even a product or an industry. It is in this second sense that Saint Paul calls us ambassadors. Each of us by virtue of our baptism represents the Catholic faith and by implication the teachings of Jesus Christ and Jesus Himself. In that sense, we are the Lord's ambassadors to the world. People who do not know about the Catholic faith but who know we are Catholics will look to us for insights on what Catholics believe and on how they live. Through our words, our actions, our example and our prayers we

make our faith known to them. So then, let us then be intentional about how we live, conscious of the fact that we are modeling the Catholic faith to others. Let us do our best to bring the love of Christ to those who do not know Him. It is through us that God the Father appeals to others and also allows us to share in the saving mission of our Lord Jesus Christ.
