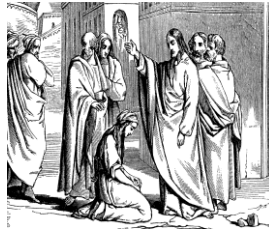

FROM THE PASTOR

PALM SUNDAY & HOLY WEEK

Lent is fast drawing to a close and Holy Week begins next week with our observance of Palm Sunday. On that day, new Palms will be blessed for the year. Holy Week is the most sacred time of the Church year, and during that time, we should continue our works of prayer, penance and almsgiving. Plan to attend the special liturgies on Holy Thursday, Good Friday and the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday.

CHRISM MASS

Each year, a special Mass is celebrated at the Cathedral where Bishop Daniel will bless and consecrate the holy oils used for the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, Anointing of the Sick and Holy Orders. At that Mass, all of the priests of the Diocese gather and renew the promises they made at their ordination. Representatives from all of the parishes in the Diocese also attend. At the end of Mass, the representatives come forward to bring the oils for their particular parishes back home to be used for the coming year. I would encourage all who can to attend this special Mass. It will begin at 5:30pm. on Monday, April 14th at the Cathedral of Our Lady in Duluth.

COMMUNAL PENANCE NEXT SUNDAY

There will be a Communal Penance Service next Sunday, April 13th from 6:00 to 7:00pm at Saint Patrick's. Two priests will be hearing confessions. There will also be a Communal Penance Service at Immaculate Conception in Pine City on Tuesday, April 15th from 6:30 to 7:30pm. These are excellent opportunities for you to go to Confession before Easter.
